When you first visit IMMIGE.com, you will be asked to give your consent to storage of certain cookies on your computer, you can give or withhold consent and change your mind at any given time by accessing your cookie settings through the settings link at the top of each screen while on IMMIGE.com.

We hope that after you have read our policy you will have sufficient details about the 'cookies' used on our website to be reassured that we use them responsibly.

What is a cookie?

A 'cookie' is a very small piece of information in the form of a text file placed on your computer hard drive by lots of the websites that you visit. 'Cookies' allow us to help you get the best out of your visit to the website and improve your user experience, for instance by remembering that you have visited before. They can also be used to make sure that any advertising you see is relevant to you.

In this policy we have used the following categories of 'cookies':

- Strictly Necessary
- Performance
- Functionality
- Targeting

This categorisation has been defined by The International Chamber of Commerce (UK).

Our 'cookies' are used to store basic information, like your user identification. They do not store password or credit card information.

Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly necessary 'cookies' are set to help support the structure of the pages that are displayed to you. These help the website to function and enhance the look and feel

of the website. They also help to improve navigation around our website and allow you to return to pages you have previously visited. This type of 'cookie' only lasts for the duration of the time you are visiting the website. When you leave the website, they are deleted automatically.

Performance Cookies

Performance 'cookies' are used to provide statistical information about visits to our website and general browsing behaviour. This enables us to organise the website and to make our users' experiences easier, and if necessary, make improvements. The data is combined and made anonymous, which means we cannot identify you as an individual.

We use a number of tools to carry out analytical functions on our site including Google Analytics.

Functionality Cookies

Functionality 'cookies' are used to make accessing the website more convenient, so you don't need to remember your username / email address. This information will allow us to welcome you by name, and over time to personalise our website content to reflect your preferences. For security reasons, you will still need to enter your password.

Our 'cookie' will remain on your hard drive until you choose to delete it. If you choose to do this, you will need to enter your details each time you visit the site. It is possible for you to view our website without providing any personal information, but you will need to register your details so we can process any online transactions. An advantage of registering is that we will be able to contact you about special offers from which you can benefit.

Targeting Cookies i.e., Third Party Cookies and Cookies used for Advertising

Targeting 'cookies' are used to help us understand the performance of our marketing activity and improve the relevance of the adverts that you see. We use these 'cookies' to display products and services that we think will interest you, both on our website and on other websites across the internet.

We may set these 'cookies' on your computer and allow carefully selected third parties to do the same while you are browsing our site. These will collect information about your browsing habits and allow us to show you adverts while you are browsing our site and other sites on the internet.

Cookie Maintenance

You can set your browser to accept or reject all specific 'cookies'. You can delete 'cookies' that have been stored on your computer but, if you prevent us from placing 'cookies' on your computer during your visit or you subsequently delete a 'cookie' that has been placed, it may not be possible for you to use our website effectively.

By disabling your 'cookies' from the browser settings, you will be restricting the 'cookies' that we use to manage the website and this will have an impact on how the website will function. This will apply to all websites once 'cookies' are disabled via your browser settings, not only to our website.

If you would like to restrict or block 'cookies' that are set by us and other websites, you can do this through your web browser settings. Please use the Help function on your browser for detailed instructions on how to do this. For information on how to restrict or block 'cookies' on your mobile phone, you may need to refer to your handset manual.
